## PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

### MONITORING VIOLATION OF THE WATER TESTING SCHEDULE

Our water system violated a drinking water standard(s) over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

We, the MontiPark Public Water Supply are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During August we did not monitor or test one sample for bacteria and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time. This sample should have gone to the State lab.

#### **What should I do?**

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

#### **What Happened? What is being done?**

The licensed operator (who also runs Anamosa's water system) is taking over sending the water samples to the State lab.
